Change of use and siting of side opening storage containers for the storage of goods by homeowners and small businesses.

The Parish Council have agreed to object the planning application on the grounds of the site which is located on a narrow single-track road with no formal passing places. It is not suitable for the additional traffic this seven container self-store proposal would generate. This winter Kents Green Road has twice been closed due to flooding from Red Brook adjacent to Taynton Parva and it also floods at the low point 120m west of the proposed site entrance.
